 - Contributed to the development of a Webby nominated, Rails-based social network.
 - Implemented features and fixed bugs on an mission critical JSF / Spring / Hibernate application monitoring systems for the food service industry. Worked on a Sproutcore web-based client that would interface with backend web services.
